Satellites orbiting the earth and probes sent to other planets are called "spacecrafts". In order to complete its mission, a spacecraft is controlled to point in the direction of its target. This is called attitude control, and its motion is governed by attitude dynamics. In order to control the attitude, measurement of its attitude is also important, and since humans cannot measure it directly, the attitude should appropriately be estimated by combining various sensor information. In this laboratory, we study on attitude dynamics, attitude estimation, and attitude control. Master/Doctor course: Education policy, curriculum, typical activity in the laboratory Graduate students in the Master's and Doctoral courses will have weekly research meetings with their supervisors to report on progress, discuss, and confirm issues. In addition, we aim to introduce relevant English literature twice a semester. Through these meetings, students will acquire new knowledge and the ability to discuss. In addition, inlab seminars will be held to learn know-how and skills useful for research activities. At the end of the course, students in the Master's course are expected to be able to come up with solutions to given problems by themselves, and students in the Doctoral course are expected to be able to find and solve problems by Daily life in the laboratory, etc. High-speed computers and computing software are provided as common facilities and can be used freely. The laboratory will be equipped with electronic tools, measuring instruments, 3D printers, and other equipment necessary for constructing experimental devices. Depending on your research theme, your own equipment and software will be installed in the actual spacecraft.
