<p>Plants were diversified through geologic time and diversification still goes on. We are trying to clarify how such plant diversities were generated by using methods of taxonomy, phylogeny, anatomy and developmental biology. Now, we are especially focusing on evolution of early land plants, mainly using bryophytes, 1) Developmental mechanism of 3D patterning and cellular differentiation, 2) Developmental process of sexual reproductive organs, 3) Phylogeny of basal land plants using developmental process and molecular data.</p>
